



# The UWI FIC Dame Yvonne Maginley Memorial Scholarship

## Terms of Awards

Dame Yvonne Maginley DCN, CMG, OBE, OD, was a trailblazer for women who served the nation of Antigua and Barbuda with distinction in the areas of tourism and culture. She entered the fledgeling male-dominated tourism sector and was appointed in 1958 as the Executive Secretary of the Antigua Tourist Board. It was during this time that Dame Yvonne was part of a team of visionaries who crafted the foundations of our current tourism sector in a move that transitioned Antigua and Barbuda from an agrarian-based economy into a service-based economy. Having reached the *pièce de résistance* of national service, Dame Yvonne was appointed and served as the Governor-General's Deputy between 1999-2004.
